1. Will there be toilets and baby changing facilities available at the event?

2. Will there be food and drink available at the event?

Yes. Businesses along the Seafront will be open during their normal business hours.

3. Can I bring my dog to the event?

Yes, however all dogs must be kept on the lead.

Road Closure and Parking Information

1. Which roads will be closed during the event?

Some road closures and restricted access will be in place along Marine Walk, the Marina and the Seafront during the weekend but please be assured that the council and British Triathlon are working very hard to minimise disruption.

A letter outlining exact timings and additional information about parking and access will be delivered in July.

2. I'm a resident, will I need a parking permit?

We are currently working on road closure logistics and more detail will be confirmed in due course. Any residents affected will be contacted by letter in July.

3. Can I use public transport to get to the event?

4. As a spectator to the event where can I park?

Limited Seafront Parking is available at Dykelands Road, SR6 7QE on a first come, first served basis. We would ask all visitors to park responsibly. Please note that Marine Walk and Harbour View car parks will be closed for the event.

5. I have a Blue Badge, where can I park?

There is limited Blue Badge parking on the Seafront including Whitburn Road opposite Queens Parade and Dykelands Road Car Park, SR6 7QE. These operate on a first come, first served basis.
